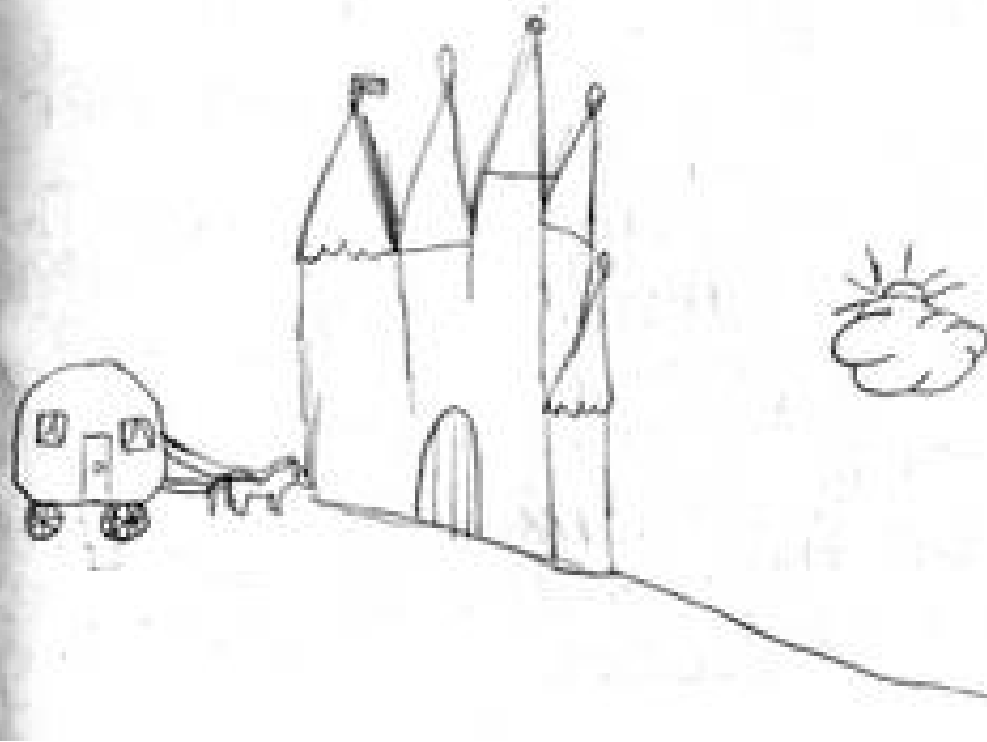
Serena turned around on the seat and gave him a slight squeeze as if to say "thank you very much."

# Chapter 4.

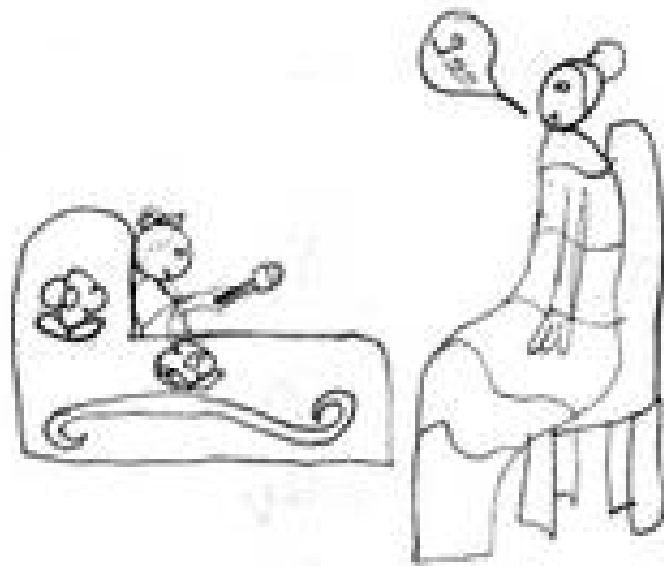
